## Basic godly living 2 Chronicles 17

- I. My personal life: God is my priority and I see him working in my life (2 Chronicles 17:3-6).
  - A. God's blessing: God was with him (3-4).
    - Jehoshaphat followed King David's godly example (3a).
    - Jehoshaphat *sought* God and rejected the evil practices around him (3b, 4).
  - B. *God's blessing:* God established his authority and people brought him gifts (5).
    - His heart was devoted to the Lord (6a).
    - He removed temptations to evil (6b).
- II. <u>Ministry</u>: I seek to impact others with God's word (2 Chronicles 17:7-11).
  - A. Jehoshaphat appointed officials, Levites and priests to teach God's word (7-9).
  - B. *God's blessing:* The fear of the Lord fell on nearby kingdoms who brought him gifts (10-11).
  - III. <u>Job</u>: I work diligently to benefit those around me and bring security to those who rely on me (2 Chronicles 17:12-19).
    - A. *God's blessing:* Jehoshaphat became very powerful.
    - B. He secured Judah financially (12-13).
    - C. He secured Judah militarily (1-2; 14-19).
