True Strength 1 Kings 2

- Put God first David gave final words to Solomon about strong leadership (1 Kings 2:1-12).
 - A. Obey God Solomon must personally commit himself to follow God (1-4).
 - 1. A strong man pursues God with absolute obedience (1-3a).
 - 2. A spiritually strong man experiences God's blessings (3b-4).
 - B. <u>Address evil</u> Solomon must deal with spiritually dangerous men (5-12).
 - Joab (5-6) and Shimei (7-9) must be punished after David dies (10-12).
- II. <u>Do hard things</u> Solomon had courage to do what was needed to protect God's people (1 Kings 2:13-46).
 - A. Executing Adonijah Dealing with a threat to the throne of Israel (13-25)
 - B. Dismissing Abiathar Disciplining a spiritual betrayer (26-27)
 - C. Executing Joab Following through on a long overdue justice (28-35)
 - D. Executing Shimei Following through on a clearly forewarned justice (36-46)
