## Blessed to be a blessing 1 Kings 3:16 – 4:34

- I. God gave Solomon <u>judicial wisdom</u> to assure <u>fairness</u> for the people (1 Kings 3: 16-28).
  - A. A tragic dilemma and dispute (16-22)
  - B. Brilliant and compassionate justice (23-28)

What <u>decision-making</u> has God entrusted to you that can bring compassion and justice to people God loves?

- II. God gave Solomon <u>administrative wisdom</u> to supply <u>provisions and peace</u> (1 Kings 4:1-28)
  - A. Cabinet officials to oversee the nation (4:1-6)
  - B. Commissioners responsible for palace provisions (4:7-19)
  - C. Evidence that God blessed Solomon's leadership
    - Prosperous and happy people (20)
    - Financial and military security (21-24)
    - Individuals peace and safety (25)
    - Fully supplied court (26-28)

What <u>management responsibility</u> has God given you that can enable others to feel provided for and secure?

- III. God gave Solomon <u>teaching wisdom</u> to <u>improve the lives</u> of others (1 Kings 4:29-34).
  - A. Greater wisdom than anyone in the world (4:29-33)
    - Proverbs for peace, safety, godliness
    - Songs to celebrate and enjoy life
    - Educational materials
  - B. Great reputation all around the world (4:34)
