SERMON OUTLINE

God's sovereign help 2 Samuel 16:15-18:18

- I. God sovereignly protected David through Hushai's advice (16:15-17:14).
 - A. Hushai infiltrated Absalom's inner circle (16:15-19)
 - B. Absalom followed Ahithophel's advice about appropriating David's mistresses (16:20-23).
 - C. Absalom follows Hushai's "bad advice" to delay attacking David (17:1-14).
 - ❖ God divinely deceived Absalom to follow Hushai's "bad" advice (17:14).
- II. God <u>sovereignly directed</u> David to safety through spies and providence (17:15-23).
 - A. Hushai told the priests who told a servant girl who told their sons to warn David, but Absalom found out (15-18a).
 - B. The messengers hid from Absalom's men, so the message got through to David (18b-22).
 - C. Ahithophel committed suicide (23).
- III. God sovereignly provided for David through friends (17:24-29).
 - A. Amasa led Absalom's forces (24-26).
 - B. David's allies Shobi, Makir and Barzillai providentially brought him supplies (27-29).
- IV. God sovereignly delivered David by bringing Absalom to justice (18:1-17).
 - A. David's forces defeated Absalom's (18:1-8).
 - B. Absalom "happened" to meet David's men, his head "got caught" in a tree, and Joab killed him (18:9-15).
 - C. Absalom was buried under rocks though he had built a monument to honor himself (18:16-18).
