SERMON OUTLINE

Experiencing God's glorious presence 1 Kings 8:1-11

- I. Preparing to experience God Moving the ark to the temple (1 Kings 8:1-9).
 - A. Preparing by remembering Gathering at the Feast of Tabernacles to move the ark (8:1-3)
 - B. Acknowledging Sin Bringing the ark to the temple with sacrifices (8:4-6)
 - C. Commitment to God's word Installing the ark which contained the law (8:7-9)
 - D. Praise and thanks The Levites musical praise (2 Chronicles 5:11-13-14).
 - Then the temple of the Lord was filled with the cloud... for the glory of the Lord filled the temple of God (2 Chronicles 5:13b-14).
- II. Experiencing God's presence God's glory descends on the ark (1 Kings 8:10-11)
 - A. God's glory indwelt the temple (1 Kings 8:10-11; Exodus 40:25-38).
 - B. God's glory indwelt Jesus (John 1:14, 18; Hebrews 3:3-6)
 - C. God's glory now indwells us by the Holy Spirit.
 - As believers (1 Corinthians 3:16; 6:19-20).
 - As the church (Ephesians 2:19-22; 1 Cor. 14:25).
