SERMON OUTLINE

God's relentless pursuit of our holiness 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24

How to pray ...

- I. Paul prayed that God would unceasingly move them toward the goal of holiness (1 Thessalonians 5:23a).
- II. Paul prayed that no part of their life would be untouched by God's sanctifying power in preparation for Christ's return (1 Thessalonians 5:23b).
 - A. <u>Spirit</u> Sanctification begins with realizing God's grace and power in my life (Romans 6:1-11).
 - B. <u>Soul</u> Sanctification requires I address my motives and attitudes (Psalm 139:23-24; 1 Corinthians 4:5; Hebrews 4:12).
 - C. <u>Body</u> Sanctification requires I change things I am doing (Romans 6:12-14).
 - D. <u>Motivation Christ's return</u> The goal of holiness is to prepare to meet and to enjoy Christ forever!
- III. Paul prayed that they would feel assured because God was faithfully pursuing their holiness (1 Thessalonians 5:24).
 - God will not neglect to pursue what he began!
