SERMON OUTLINE

Spiritual Leadership Acts 20:7-38

- I. <u>Teaching God's word and Acting in faith</u>: Paul taught late at Troas and resurrected the man who fell asleep (Acts 20:7-16).
 - A. <u>Teaching</u>: Paul taught all night (20:7, 11).
 - B. <u>Acting in faith</u>: Paul raised Eutychus from the dead when he fell (20:8-12).
 - C. Paul headed to Jerusalem (20:13-16).
- II. <u>Teaching and Training leaders</u>: Paul exhorted the Ephesians elders about the responsibility of spiritual leadership (Acts 20: 17-38).
 - A. History: Paul had humbly taught the Ephesians the gospel and everything helpful (20:17-21).
 - B. Future: Paul was willing to suffer for the gospel though he was innocent (20:22-27).
 - C. Spiritual Leadership Principles: Paul urged the elders to be faithful spiritual leaders (20:28-35).
 - 1. <u>Accountability</u> Constantly evaluate and adjust our own life before God.
 - 2. <u>Oversight</u> Watch over others and intervene to help them.
 - 3. <u>Shepherding</u>: Know and protect those we lead from biblical and spiritual error (20:28-31).
 - 4. <u>Studying</u>: Stay absolutely committed to God's word about grace that builds us up (20:32).
 - 5. <u>Sincere in Service</u>: Don't lead for financial gain but work hard and help the weak (20:35).
 - 6. <u>Sincere in Relationships</u>: Paul shares a tearful goodbye (20:25, 36-38).
