## **God Moments in Times of Trial**

Acts 21:1- 22:29

- I. <u>Submitting to God in Trials</u>: Paul traveled to Jerusalem as bad news loomed (Acts 21:1-26).
  - A. Various prophets warned Paul that he would be imprisoned (21:1-14).
    - Prerequisite #1 Paul submitted to God's will as he faced suffering.
  - B. James and elders warned Paul that he was accused of opposing Jewish laws (21:15-26).
    - **Prerequisite #2** Paul submitted to spiritual leaders for direction.
- II. <u>Experiencing God's Faithfulness in Trials</u>: Paul was arrested, but God continually intervened (Acts 21:27-23:11).
  - A. Paul was seized by the crowd and beaten based on false accusations (21:27-36).
    - **God moment #1** The crowd wanted to kill Paul, <u>but he is rescued</u> by reasonable officials.
  - B. Paul defended himself and the gospel to the commander and the Jewish crowd (21:37-22:29).
    - **God moment #2** Paul is accused of starting a revolt, <u>but then has</u> <u>opportunity to defend himself</u>.
    - **God moment #3** The Jews respond violently, but <u>Paul is spared from</u> <u>flogging</u> when he reveals he is a Roman citizen.
