SERMON OUTLINE

The Promise of God's Presence Acts 22:30-23:35

- I. <u>God gives us wisdom</u> when we are put on the spot: Paul appeared before the Sanhedrin (Acts 22:30-23:10).
 - A. <u>An apology</u>: Paul apologized for reacting harshly to the high priest (23:1-5).
 - B. <u>A diversion</u>: Paul brought up the doctrine of resurrection to divide the Pharisees and Sadducees (23:6-9).
 - C. Paul was rescued from their conflict and returned safely to the barracks (23:10).
- II. <u>God encourages us</u> when we are discouraged: Jesus appeared to Paul in prison assuring him of God's good plan (Acts 23:11).

Experiencing God's Presence

- 1. Be encouraged because I am always with you (Acts 23:11a; Hebrews 13:5-6).
- 2. I am with you to perfectly fulfill <u>MY</u> purposes in your life (Acts 23:11b; Matthew 28:20).
- 3. To experience My presence, meditate on My word and obey it (Joshua 1:8-9).
- III. <u>God protects us</u> when we are threatened: God exposed a plot against Paul and got him safely to Caesarea (Acts 23:12-35).
 - A. God used Paul's nephew to foil a plot to kill Paul (23:12-25).
 - B. The commander provided Paul safe passage to Governor Felix in Caesarea (23:26-35).
