Telling Your Story

Acts 25 & 26

- I. Paul appears before Governor Festus (Acts 25)
 - A. Another plot to ambush and kill Paul (25:1-5).
 - B. More accusations and defense and Paul appeals to Caesar (25:6-12).
 - C. Festus discusses Paul's case with King Agrippa and his sister Bernice (25:13-22).
 - D. Festus introduces Paul to Herod (25:23-27)
- II. Paul appears before King Agrippa (Acts 26).
 - A. Paul tells his spiritual story to King Agrippa (26:1-23) [How to share your testimony]
 - 1. My Past before Christ (26:1-11)
 - I am a Jew trained as a Pharisee, but now I believe Jesus is Messiah (26:1-8).
 - I persecuted Christians (26:9-11).
 - 2. <u>How I came to believe in Christ</u> *I met the risen Christ on the road to Damascus and put my faith in him* (26:12-18)!
 - Instructions from Jesus Go tell people they can be released from Satan and be forgiven if they believe also!
 - 3. <u>My life since believing in Christ</u> *I must serve Christ telling the good news for which I am opposed* (26:19-23).
 - Our testimony is important only as it points to the importance of the cross.
 - B. Festus calls Paul crazy (26:24-26).
 - C. Herod realizes Paul is trying to persuade him to believe in Christ (26:27-29).
- III. Herod, Bernice and Festus confer about Paul's innocence, but send him to Caesar (26:30-32).
