## Power from on High Acts 2:1-13

<u>Summary</u>: The Holy Spirit came as Jesus promised (John 14-16; Luke 24:49; Acts 1:4-5, 8), with miraculous confirmations marking the beginning of the church (2:1-13).

- I. The Holy Spirit came dramatically upon all the believers with miraculous confirmation by <u>sound and sight</u> (Acts 2:1-3).
  - A. Audible confirmation Sound of rushing wind
  - B. Visual confirmation Tongues of fire
  - All believers today <u>are baptized by the Holy Spirit</u> when they put their faith in Christ joining them to Christ and other believers permanently (1 Corinthians 12:13; Galatians 3:26-27 though there are no audible or visual confirmations of "*Spirit baptism*" today)
- II. The Holy Spirit filled all the believers and gave the apostles the miraculous confirmation of the <u>gift of tongues</u> (Acts 2:4-13).
  - A. <u>The experience</u> of the gift of tongues (2:5-11a): God enabled the apostles to speak in actual languages unknown to them but understood by the listeners (also Acts 10:46 & 19:6).
  - B. <u>The purpose</u> of the gift of tongues (2:11b-13): This gift was given not to communicate the gospel, but to praise God in various native languages, causing amazement and interest.
  - Believers today <u>are urged to be filled with the Spirit</u> which enables us to live godly as we yield obediently to Him (Acts 4:31; 13:52; Ephesians 5:18; Galatians 5:16, 22-23 though tongues do not accompany "filling" today)
