SERMON OUTLINE

How we have the power to witness Acts 1:8 and selected passages (Part 2 of a 6 part series on the gospel and evangelism)

- I. The early church had power to share the gospel.
  - A. Jesus promised that we would have power to witness when the Holy Spirit came (Acts 1:8).
  - B. When the Holy Spirit came, Peter preached with power and 3,000 people believed (Acts 2:41).
  - C. Peter and John couldn't stop talking about Jesus as the Spirit gave them boldness (Acts 4:1-31).
- II. We have power to share the gospel if we prepare to share the gospel.
  - A. <u>Know the Gospel</u> As we present the gospel in God's word, God's power saves (Romans 1:16; Hebrews 4:12).
  - B. <u>Pray</u> Prayer activates God's power as we share the gospel (Colossians 4:2-4; Ephesians 6:19-20).
    - 1. Pray seriously and thankfully as a lifestyle (Colossians 4:2).
    - 2. Pray for opportunities (Colossians 4:3).
    - 3. Pray for clarity (Colossians 4:4).
    - 4. Pray for boldness (Ephesians 6:19-20).
  - C. <u>Relax and trust God</u> As we present the gospel we can trust the Holy Spirit to convict and convince people (Acts 2:37; John 16:7-11).
