Giving with a Focus on God 1 Chronicles 28-29:9 Part 3 – Multiply

- I. God-focused Vision: David's pursued his God-focused vision to build the temple (1 Chronicles 28).
 - A. <u>A visionary heart</u>: David had it in his heart to build the temple that Solomon would eventually build (28:2).
 - B. <u>A devoted heart</u>: David challenged Solomon to be fully devoted to God who knows his heart (28:8-9).
 - C. <u>A confident heart</u>: David urged Solomon to build with courage and be assured of God's presence (28:10, 20).
- II. God-focused Generosity David and others gave with astonishing generosity to build the temple (1 Chronicles 29:1-9).
 - A. Great task: The task was great because it was for God (29:1).
 - B. Great generosity: David and his officials gave extravagantly in devotion to God (29:2-8).
 - Gold from the national treasury 3,750 ton (1 Chronicles 22:14, 29:3).
 - Gold from David personally 370 ton (29:4)
 - Gold from David's officials 190 ton (29:7)
 - D. <u>Great Joy</u>: The unusual and willing generosity to the Lord triggered immense joy among all (29:9).
