SERMON OUTLINE

God's Grace and God's Holiness Acts 4:32-5:11

- I. God is Gracious and shows grace to those who pursue His glory (Acts 4:32-37).
 - A. <u>Obedience</u>: The church was unified, generous and bold (4:32-33a).
 - B. <u>God's Grace</u>: God showed the church much grace (4:33b).
 - Grace: God pours out His grace when we desire Him to use us within the church family and to impact the world.
 - C. <u>Result</u>: The church had no financial needs because people shared generously such as Barnabas who sold a field and gave the money to the apostles to distribute (4:34-36).
 - Encouragement: Generous people are encouraging people (Barnabas).
- II. God is Holy and disciplines those who are selfish, proud and deceitful (Acts 5:1-11).
 - A. <u>Disobedience</u>: Ananias and Sapphira sold a field and gave money to the apostles to distribute, but lied about giving all the money. (5:1-4).
 - Pride: Giving is useless as worship when our motive is selfishness or pride.
 - B. <u>God's Discipline</u>: Peter confronted Ananias and Sapphira about lying to God and both were struck dead (5:5-10).
 - Accountability: We are personally accountable to God even if someone else influenced us to sin.
 - C. <u>Result</u>: Great reverence for God spread to both believers and unbelievers (5:11).
 - Fear: God uses a holy reverence to purify the church for the sake of the gospel.
