SERMON OUTLINE

Learning to pray worshipfully in hard times Psalm 63

- I. <u>Worship</u>: My greatest needs require my greatest praise (Psalm 63:1-4).
 - A. Hard times expose my longing to personally worship God for his power and glory (1-2).
 - B. I can choose to worship in hard times as I realize nothing is more valuable to me than God's love (63:3-4; Acts 16:25).
 - C. Praising God satisfies my deepest longings in spite of any trial I'm facing (5).

• Core prayer issue: I choose to <u>obediently</u> worship you God in spite of my situation.

- II. <u>Trust</u>: My greatest needs can create a greater faith (Psalm 63:6-11).
 - A. Praising God reminds me I can trust in him to bring me through my situations (6-8).
 - 1. Thinking of God when I can't sleep (6)
 - 2. Praising and clinging to God as trials persist (7-8)
 - Core prayer issue: I choose to <u>helplessly trust</u> you God with my situation.
 - B. Trusting God for outcomes
 - 1. Anticipating victory over persecutors (9-10)
 - 2. Anticipating praising God as He answers (11)
 - Core prayer issue: *I choose to <u>fully glorify you</u> <u>God</u>, as you work out your will.*
