Giving others what you want Matthew 7:12

- I. <u>The Law summarized</u>: We don't need rules to govern our relationships if we follow Christ (Matthew 7:12b).
 - Jesus taught a way of relating that fulfilled and surpassed the Law (Matthew 5:17, 20, etc.).
- II. <u>Doing means blessing</u>: Relationships thrive when we seek to bless others as we would like to be blessed (Matthew 7:12a).
 - A. The "golden rule" is NOT about how to stop certain sins or attitudes in relationships.
 - Negative principle: <u>Don't</u> do to others what you don't want them to do to you.
 - Goal Avoid sin
 - B. The "golden rule" is about taking initiate to bless others and treat everyone well.
 - Positive principle: <u>Do</u> to others what you would have them do to you.
 - Goal Bless others (The 5 love languages Gary Chapman – What blesses the other person?)
