Giving my two cent's worth Mark 12:41-44

I. <u>The way God sees our Giving</u> – Our financial giving is measured by God in terms of *sacrifice*, not *amount*.

- A. <u>Contrasting amounts given</u> The rich at the temple gave large gifts, while the widow at the temple gave only two of the smallest coins (Mark 12:41-42).
- B. <u>Giving out of **surplus**</u>: Some may give large amounts, but actually it's not costing them much if they are wealthy (Mark 12:43).
- C. <u>Giving out of sacrifice</u>: Giving a small amount financially is actually a larger gift in God's eyes because the sacrifice is greater. (Mark 12:44)
