Spiritual strength through hardship

2 Thessalonians 1:1-5, p. 958

- I. GREETINGS/BACKGROUND (2 THESSALONIANS 1:1-2)
 - Paul wrote this while serving with Silas and Timothy (1).
 - Paul reminded them of God's grace and peace (2).
 - <u>Context</u>: Their faith in Christ brought them persecution (2; Acts 17:1-15; 1 Thessalonians 1:6; 2:13-16).
- II. A GROWING FAITH CONFIDENCE IN GOD DURING TRIALS (2 THESSALONIANS 1:3a)
- III. INCREASING LOVE FOR ALL OTHER BELIEVERS (2 THESSALONIANS 1:3b)
- IV. PERSEVERANCE IN HARDSHIP (2 THESSALONIANS 1:4-5)
 - Paul was boasting to other churches about their steadfast faith in persecution and trials (1:4).
 - Paul assured them that God would approve them as worthy someday for their perseverance (1:5).
