Why it's Worth It to Abide In Christ 1 John 2:28

I. <u>Abiding In Christ</u>: We as believers must abide in Christ as His dear children (1 John 2:28a).

- A. <u>What it means to *abide in Christ*</u>: To enjoy the love and security of our relationship with God and to respond to Him in ways that please Him.
- B. <u>What's included in *abiding in Christ* (1 John):</u>
 - 1. Imitating Christ by the way we live (1 John 2:6)
 - 2. Loving others in our spiritual family (1 John 2:10)
 - 3. Immersing ourselves in God's Word (1 John 2:14, 24), depending on the Holy Spirit to teach us (1 John 2:27)
 - 4. Drawing close to Christ so that we follow Him out of love, not fear (1 John 2:28; 3:1; 4:16,17).

II. <u>Anticipating Christ's Return</u>: If we abide in Christ we will joyfully anticipate meeting Him when He comes (1John 2:28b; 4:16,17).

- A. Christ is coming back and will evaluate our lives.
 - 1. <u>Rapture</u> Christ will return (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18).
 - 2. <u>Review</u> Christ will evaluate our life as believers in order to reward what has eternal value (1 Corinthians 3:10-15; 2 Corinthians 5:10).
- B. Abiding in Christ determines how we view Christ's return (1 John 2:28).
 - 1. <u>With Confidence & Joy</u>, because we are focused on Christ's approval (1 John 4:17; 1 Corinthians 4:5; 9:24-27).
 - 2. <u>With Shame</u>, because we love the world and their approval (Mark 8:38/Luke 9:26; John 12:42-43; 1 John 2:15-17).

<u>Personal Evaluation</u>: Are we abiding in Christ? Are we living for God's approval or men's? Can Christ reward our life as we are now living it?
