God's sobering justice and amazing grace

2 Thessalonians 1:6-10, p. 959

- I. <u>GOD'S JUSTICE</u>: GOD IS JUST AND WILL ETERNALLY PUNISH THOSE WHO OPPOSE OR REJECT THE GOSPEL (1 THESSALONIANS 1:6-9).
 - A. God will exercise His justice on those who persecute believers suffering for the gospel (6).
 - B. Jesus Christ will punish with eternal destruction those who reject the gospel when He returns as Judge (7-8).
 - C. Hell is a condition of continual punishment and separation from God (9 *also, hades, hell, lake of fire Rev. 20:14-15*).
- II. <u>GOD'S GRACE</u>: WHEN JESUS RETURNS AS JUDGE, IT WILL DISPLAY GOD'S GRACE FOR SINNERS WHO BELIEVE THE GOSPEL (1 THESSALONIANS 1:10).
 - A. "Glorified in" When Jesus returns as Judge we believers are a glorious display of God's grace, which makes sinners holy (10a).
 - B. "Marveled at" When Jesus returns as Judge we believers are a multitude marveling at His glory and justice (10b).
