Prayer is Spiritual Battle

Ephesians 6:18-20

I. Pray for God's strength against Satan's spiritual attacks against us (Ephesians 6:18).

A. Praying in the Spirit

- > Do I rely on the Spirit so I can pray effectively (Romans 8:26-27)?
- B. Praying on all occasions with all kinds of prayers
 - Do I pray continually about the spiritual struggles I face (Colossians 4:2; 1 Thessalonians 5:17)?
- C. Praying alertly and consistently for each other
 - Do I just pray for my own struggles or do I intercede for "all the saints" in their spiritual struggles?
 - > Do I work hard to concentrate when I pray (Colossians 4:2)?
- II. Pray for those who share the gospel against Satan's opposition (Ephesians 6:19-20).
 - A. Pray against the "strongholds" of Satan's lies against the gospel (2 Corinthians 10:3-5).
 - B. Paul asked for prayer as he shared the gospel in prison and elsewhere (Ephesians 6:19-20).
 - For Clarity and Opportunity Pray for Christians to communicate the gospel clearly (19a; Colossians 4:3, 4).
 - ➢ For Courage Pray for Christians to communicate the gospel boldly (19b, 20).
