How to pray for other Christians (and myself)

2 Thessalonians 1:11-12, p. 959

- I. TO BE WORTHY PRAY THAT THEY WILL REFLECT THE PRIVILEGE OF THEIR SALVATION (2 THESSALONIANS 1:11).
 - *Worthy* Does my life increasingly align with God's purpose for saving me (1 Thessalonians 2:12; 1 Corinthians 1:2; Ephesians 4:1)?
 - A. Inward spiritual growth That God grows their desire for good
 - Desire...goodness Do I desire what is truly good or just what I selfishly want?
 - B. External spiritual service That God fulfills their desire to serve
 - Work of faith Am I striving to serve how God wants me to serve?
- II. FOR CHRIST'S GLORY PRAY THAT CHRIST WOULD BE PRAISED WHICH IS OUR ULTIMATE PRIVILEGE (2 THESSALONIANS 1:12).
 - A. The Lord Jesus might be glorified in you Our spiritual progress displays Christ's power, not ours (12a).
 - B. And you (glorified) in Him according to... grace As we grow and serve, we share the privilege of God's work in us (12b).
