SERMON OUTLINE

How God Honors Our Faith

Mark 5:25-34

I. The Woman's Plight (Mark 5:25-26)

- A. Physical suffering through bleeding for 12 years
- B. Emotional suffering as it got worse, not better
- C. <u>Financial suffering</u> through spending all her money
- D. <u>Social suffering</u> through being ceremonially unclean
 - An unclean person made other people unclean by touching them (Leviticus 15:25-31; Haggai 2:10-14).

II. The Woman's Faith and Healing (Mark 5:27-29)

- A. <u>Her Immature Faith</u>: The woman had an immature faith –thought healing was based on touching Jesus' clothes.
- B. <u>Christ's Amazing Grace:</u> Jesus honored her simple faith and healed her.
 - Asking is key to receiving (Matthew 7:7-8; James 5:16).
 - > Jesus was not made unclean by the woman. Rather He made her clean like salvation today (Romans 3:22).

III. The Woman's Conversation with Jesus (Mark 5:30-34)

- A. *Who touched me?* Jesus knew his power was used (30-32).
- B. *Trembling woman/whole truth* Jesus calls out the woman and she tells Him the whole story of her suffering and desire for His healing (33).
 - Our trials and God's answers are not jut for our benefit, but for the benefit of others. We must take courage to tell our story to others as a testimony of God's goodness.
 - > We can be honest with God about trials (Lament Psalms),
- C. Your Faith has healed/saved you (34)
 - > Daughter Jesus' compassion, commendation, assurance and clarification about her faith.
 - Healed/Saved A word used in the Bible for both physical and spiritual deliverance. (Context determines)
