The peace of knowing God's prophetic plan

2 Thessalonians 2:1-12, p. 959

- I. <u>THEIR QUESTIONS</u>: DON'T BE DISTURBED ABOUT THE FUTURE BY FALSE TEACHERS (2 THESSALONIANS 2:1-2).
 - A. Don't be confused about the rapture of the church (2:1).
 - Oh no, was Paul wrong about Jesus rapturing the church?
 - B. Don't believe false reports about the Day of the Lord (2:2).
 - Oh no, did Paul say the judgments of the Day of the Lord were already here?
- II. <u>PAUL'S ANSWERS</u>: RELAX, THE DAY OF THE LORD IS STILL FUTURE (2 THESSALONIANS 2:3-12).
 - A. We are NOT in the Day of the Lord because the rapture hasn't happened and the Antichrist has not been revealed (2:3-4).
 - 1. The departure must come first (3a-Apostasy OR Rapture?).
 - Lit. "Departure" Likely the departure of Christians at the rapture instead of departure from truth by unbelievers
 - 2. The Man of sin/Antichrist must be revealed in temple (3b/4).
 - B. Remember what I taught about the Day of the Lord (2:5-12).
 - 1. The Restrainer (Holy Spirit) must be removed (5-7).
 - 2. The Lawless One (Antichrist) will be revealed (in Tribulation) and destroyed when Jesus comes (end of Tribulation, 8).
 - 3. The Antichrist will satanically deceive unbelievers who perish eternally because they hate truth and love wickedness (9-12).
