Refocusing on what really matters

2 Thessalonians 2:13-17, p. 959

- I. THANK GOD FOR YOUR SPIRITUALLY SECURE POSITION (2 THESSALONIANS 2:13-15).
 - A. Rest secure in your salvation and standing with God (2:13-14).
 - I am loved by the Lord (13a).
 - I am chosen by God from eternity past (13b; Ephesians 1:4).
 - I was saved by the work of the Spirt when I believed (13c).
 - I was called to salvation when I heard the gospel so I could forever experience the glory of Christ (14).
 - B. Since you are secure, pursue spiritual stability (2:15).
 - 1. Stand firm Decide your spiritual direction (15a).
 - 2. Hold fast Commit to do what God's Word teaches (15b).
- II. ASK GOD FOR SPIRITUAL STRENGTH AND ENCOURAGEMENT (2 THESSALONIANS 2:16-17).
 - A. Effective prayer begins with knowing God's love and our secure position is based on grace alone (2:16).
 - B. Paul prayed for their encouragement (2:17a).
 - C. Paul prayed for their strength to serve God effectively (2:17b).
