I Did It My Way Judges 21

I. <u>Extremism</u> – <u>No Restraint</u> in battle (Judges 20:43 – 21:6)

- A. Extreme destruction of life in the war with Benjamin (20:43-48)
- B. Extreme vow to never marry Benjamites (21:1)
- C. Extreme vow to kill anyone who didn't come to fight Benjamin (21:5)
- D. Results: The felt regret and grief because the tribe of Benjamin was almost wiped out (21:2-4,6)

II. <u>Impulsiveness</u> – <u>Not seeking God</u> (Judges 21:7-24)

- A. Impulsive idea of killing everyone in Jabesh-Gilead and sparing the virgins as wives for the Benjamites (21:7-14)
- B. Impulsive idea of stealing women from Shiloh to provide more wives for Benjamites (21:15-24)
- C. Results: They ravished families, young women, and then had to rationalize what they had done (21:22).
 > Foolish decisions result when we act on our emotions.
 > Sin complicates things so there seems to be no good solution.

III. <u>Independence</u> – <u>No leadership or wisdom</u> (Judges 21:25)

- A. <u>No King Lack of leadership</u>: They were not accountable to the counsel of wise people with the big picture.
- B. <u>As he saw fit Lack of wisdom</u>: They independently did what they thought best instead of seeking God and waiting on His will.
