Recovery from Spiritual Failure

(Moving on from Forgiveness)
Joshua 8

- I. Regrouping after Defeat Forgiveness and Encouragement. God tells Joshua to plan for victory over Ai (Joshua 8: 1-9)
 - Because God forgives, we can be encouraged and again enjoy His promises.

Two Kinds of Forgiveness

- Eternal Forgiveness Have I trusted in Jesus Christ that He took the eternal punishment for my sin? Am I saved? (John 3:16)
- Continual Forgiveness As a believer, have I confessed my known sins? Am I living in fellowship with God? (1 John 1:7-9)
- Resuming Victory Forgiveness and Moving On: Joshua leads Israel to victory over Ai & Bethel (Joshua 8:10-29).
 - God has a plan for us to be victorious in the same area where we have previously experienced defeat.
 - When we know we are forgiven we can move on to do what God wants us to do next.

Pictures of God's forgiveness

- Whiter than snow/like wool Psalm 51:2, 7; Isaiah 1:18
- Removed... as far as the east is from the west Psalm 103:12
- > Swept away like a cloud... like the morning mist Isaiah 44:22
- Hurled into the depths of the sea Micah 7:19
- III. Renewing our Commitment Forgiveness and Newness: Renewal of the covenant at Mt. Ebal and Mt. Gerazim (Joshua 8:30-35).
 - Maintaining spiritual victory means making a new commitment to God's word.
