## A church committed to the gospel

2 Thessalonians 3:1-5, p. 959

- I. PAUL <u>REQUESTED PRAYER</u> FOR EFFECTIVENESS AS HE DECLARED THE GOSPEL (2 THESSALONIANS 3:1-2).
  - A. Pray that the gospel spreads rapidly (3:1).
  - B. Pray that our spiritual enemies will not deter the gospel (3:2).
- II. PAUL <u>ASSURED</u> THE CHURCH GOD FAITHFULLY ANSWERS GOSPEL PRAYERS (2 THESSALONIANS 3:3).
  - A. God will faithfully support the church in its mission (3:3a).
  - B. God will faithfully protect the church from Satan's effort (3:3b).
- III. PAUL <u>ENCOURAGED</u> THE CHURCH BY EXPRESSING CONFIDENCE IN THEM (2 THESSALONIANS 3:4-5).
  - A. Their ministry: Paul expressed confidence in Christ that they would keep doing what Paul told them (3:4).
  - B. Their motives: Paul was praying they would be motivated by God's love and Christ's endurance (3:5).
