# The Price of Prayerlessness Joshua 9

I. If we are deceived, we will make bad decisions: The Deception of the Gibeonites (Joshua 9:1-13).

#### **Principles**

- 1. After times of spiritual victory we can become complacent, self-assured and spiritually negligent.
- 2. We are easily deceived when someone flatters us.
- 3. Just because someone seems godly and sincere does not mean that we should make spiritual alliances with them.
- II. When we don't pray, we make bad decisions: The response of Joshua and the other leaders (Joshua 9:14-15).

# **Principles**

- 1. If we don't plan to always pray we will forget to pray.
- 2. God will give us wisdom if we seek it from Him instead of human sources.
- 3. The majority of good godly people can still be wrong if they don't pray for wisdom.
- III. When we don't pray, we must live with the consequences of bad decisions: Israel must live with their agreement (Joshua 9:16-26).

## **Principles**

- 1. When we agree to do something, we have live with our agreements even if they were ill-advised.
- 2. God can sovereignly bless people in spite of bad decisions.
