Selected Proverbs

I. Honesty in our Words

- A. God watches over all truth (22:12).
- B. God loves truth and hates lies (6:17,19; 12:22).
- C. Lying reveals our character.
 - 1. Lying reveals the condition of the heart (12:20).
 - 2. Lying reveals hatred for God (14:2).
 - 3. Lying reveals hatred for people (25:18; 26:28).

Why We Lie and Deceive

- <u>Guilt</u> To avoid getting caught and punished
- <u>Fear</u> To avoid financial loss, humiliation, consequences
- <u>Greed</u> To get or keep what we don't deserve
- <u>Hate</u> To hurt or spite someone, revenge
- <u>Pride</u> To get attention, impress false claims, exaggeration, flattery
- <u>Laziness</u> To get out of doing something excuses
- <u>Comfort</u> To get perks or sympathy

D. Truth pays off; lying doesn't.

- 1. Lying brings consequences (19:5).
- 2. Truth gives security and lessens our anxiety (10:9).
- 3. Truth makes decisions easier (11:3).
- 4. Truth heals relationships (15:4).

II. Honesty in our Finances

- A. God watches over our business ethics (15:1).
- B. God loves honesty and hates dishonesty.
 - 1. Balances (11:1; 16:11; 20:10,23)
 - 2. Boundaries (22:28; 23:10)
 - 3. Bribes (15:27; 17:23)
 - 4. Overcharging (28:8)
 - 5. Being cheap (20:14)
- C. We can trust God when we're honest (28:20, 25).
- D. The good and godly love honesty (13:5; 30:8; 16:13).
