## Providence and Responsibility Ruth 2

- I. Scene 1 Ruth goes to work: God providentially honored Ruth as she was faithful in her work (Ruth 2:1-7)
  - A. Working in the right place Ruth took initiative, but God's plan put her in the right field (2:1-3)
  - B. Working hard and being noticed Ruth worked hard, but God made sure the right people noticed her (2:4-7).
- II. Scene 2 <u>Boaz blesses Ruth</u>: God providentially cared for Ruth as she faithfully cared for Naomi (Ruth 2:8-16).
  - A. Boaz gave Ruth protection and praise (2:8-13).
    - 1. Protection Boaz insists that Ruth work in the safety of his fields (8-9).
    - Praise Boaz praises Ruth for taking care of Naomi and for seeking God as her refuge (10-13).
  - B. Boaz gave Ruth position and provision (2:14-16).
    - 1. Position Boaz insists that Ruth eat with him
    - 2. Provision Boaz tells his workers to deliberately leave extra grain for Ruth (15-16)
- III. Scene 3 Naomi realizes God's providence: God's providence with Ruth assures Naomi that God cares for her (Ruth 2:17-23).
  - A. When Ruth returns with much grain, Naomi realizes that someone has blessed her deliberately (2:17-18).
  - B. When Naomi finds out it was Boaz, she recognizes God's providence (2:19-23).
