## Learning the Miracle of Ministry Mark 6:35-44

## I. <u>Human Solutions</u>: The disciples assumed that human needs should be met by human solutions (Mark 6:35-36).

- A. The disciples wanted to send the people away.
  - > If we love Jesus we will serve Jesus.
- B. The disciples see a human need and suggest a human solution.

## II. <u>God's Solution</u>: Jesus involves the disciples in His miraculous provision (Mark 6:37-44).

- A. God gets us involved in the process of His miracles (6:37-38).
  - 1. You help them The needs of people are overwhelming.
    - > We need to realize how inadequate we are to accomplish real ministry for God.
  - 2. *What do you have?* God uses what we have.
    - God is not limited by how small or insignificant our part is in His work when we are faithful with what we have.
- B. God miraculously provides in ways that only He can do (6:39-44).
  - 1. Gave thanks Giving advance thanks to God (Philippians 4:6)
  - 2. *He gave/divided* <u>Miraculous provision</u>
    - ▶ God can use me when I know that He doesn't need me (Ephesians 3:20).
