Satan plots, but God plans

Luke 22:1-38, p. 855 (Part 1 of 7 – Luke 22-24)

- I. SATAN PLOTTED TO KILL JESUS AS JESUS PLANNED PASSOVER WITH HIS DISCIPLES (LUKE 22:1-13).
 - A. Satan plotted to kill Jesus by Judas betraying Him (22:1-6).
 - B. Jesus made plans for Passover with His disciples (22:7-13).
- II. THE LAST SUPPER PICTURED GOD'S PLAN OF ETERNAL SALVATION (LUKE 22:14-23).
 - A. Jesus greatly desired this Passover before the cross (22:14-18).
 - B. The bread: Christ's substitutionary death for our sin (22:19).
 - C. The cup: Our new covenant relationship with God (22:20).
 - D. Jesus exposed Judas' betrayal and judgment (22:21-23).
- III. JESUS ANTICIPATED THE SPIRITUAL BATTLES HIS FOLLOWERS WOULD FACE (LUKE 22:24-38).
 - A. <u>Pride</u>: As the disciples argued who was greatest, Jesus taught that serving like Him is the greatest (22:24-30).
 - B. <u>Temptation</u>: Jesus warned Peter that Satan would try to destroy him but Jesus' prayer would give Peter victory (22:31-34; Acts 3-4).
 - C. Opposition: The disciples would face persecution for the gospel (22:35-38).
 - Satan is powerless when we simply obey God (James 4:7).
