Embracing God's difficult will

Luke 22:39-65, p. 856 (Part 2 of 7 – Luke 22-24)

- I. JESUS PRAYED IN GETHSEMANE ACCEPTING GOD'S WILL IN SPITE OF THE COST (LUKE 22:39-46).
 - A. Jesus was concerned about the disciples' temptations (39-40).
 - B. Jesus passed the test of willingness to die on the cross (41-44).
 - C. The disciples failed the test of staying awake to pray (45-46).
- II. JESUS WAS ARRESTED IN GETHSEMANE SILENTLY ENDURING THE COST OF GOD'S WILL (LUKE 22:47-53).
 - A. Judas kissed Jesus to betray Him (47-48).
 - B. Peter cut off the high priest's servant's ear (49-51; John 18:10).
 - C. Jesus accepted His arrest silently (52-53).
- III. PETER DENIED KNOWING JESUS REFUSING TO PAY THE COST OF GOD'S WILL (Luke 22:54-65).
 - A. Peter denied three times that He knew Jesus (54-60).
 - B. Jesus silently acknowledged Peter's denials (61-62).
 - C. Jesus silently endured the guards' abuse (63-65).
