SERMON OUTLINE

Life that comes from Death

Isaiah 53:10-12

- I. Belonging: Christ's death and resurrection gives me life in his family (53:10).
 - A. OFFERED FOR ME: God's plan required offering Jesus as a guilt offering for our sin (10a).
 - B. I'M FAMILY NOW: God's plan resulted in many spiritual children as Jesus rose from the dead (10b; Hebrews 2:10-12; Galatians 3:26).
- II. <u>Cleansing</u>: Christ's death and resurrection makes me righteous in God's sight (53:11).
 - A. IT WAS ACCOMPLISHED: Jesus' painful death and resurrection accomplished our salvation (11a).
 - B. GOD SEES ME AS RIGHTEOUS: If we acknowledge by faith Christ paid for our sin we are declared righteous (11b; Romans 3:20-22; 4:24; Psalm 32:2).
- III. Praise the Servant who is now the exalted King (53:12).
 - A. AS KING, HE IS NOW EXALTED: Christ was rewarded for conquering sin and death (12a).
 - Jesus is now exalted by the Father and worthy of all praise for accomplishing our redemption (Philippians 2:9-11; Revelation 5:12).
 - B. AS SERVANT, HE SERVED ME: Christ died for us (12b).
 - He voluntarily gave his life, identified with sinners, took our penalty and now intercedes for us (Romans 8:27, 34; Hebrews 4:16).
