 - A. Encouragement from the past (20:17-21)
 - Paul's humility and fervency in serving God (17-19)
 - > Paul's faithful teaching in public and homes (20-21)
 - B. Exhortation about the future (20:22-38)
 - > Expect hardship based on Paul's example (22-27).
 - ➤ Guard for error and shepherd God's people (28-31).
 - > Stay true to God's Word and Grace (32).
 - > Be content, work hard and serve the weak (33-35).
