# Loving God by Loving His Family

1 John 4:20-5:2

- I. We love God by loving His other children (4:20-5:1).
  - A. We don't love God who we cannot see if we don't love our brother who we can see (4:20-21).
  - B. Everyone who believes in Christ is my "brother" whom I must love (5:1).
    - I cannot choose which Christians I am going love.

# Excuses for Not Loving my "brother"

- Not my type Socially undesirable, image at stake
- No tolerance for their weakness/sin Lack of grace
- I was hurt Offense, history, lack of forgiveness
- *Uncomfortable, Different* Culture/race/accent
- I'm shy Unwilling to be unselfishly courageous
- No Time Selfish
- I like my friends Peer pressure, what others think of me
- II. We love our spiritual siblings by loving and obeying God (5:2).
  - ➤ It's not just "my own business" how I live as a believer. I truly influence others by how much I love and obey God.

# My life affects other believers

### The Body/The Building

(Ephesians 2:21) "In him (Christ) the <u>whole building</u> is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord." (See also 1 Corinthians 12:12-31 – the Body)

### The Stumbling Block Principle

 (1 Corinthians 8:9) "Be careful, however, that the exercise of your freedom does not become a stumbling block to the weak."
