Why God Saves Us Ephesians 1:7-12

I. *Our salvation*: We are redeemed because <u>God is lavishly gracious</u> <u>through Christ</u> (Ephesians 1:7-8a).

- A. Through Christ's death we have the blessing of <u>redemption</u> (1:7a).
- B. Through Christ's death we have the blessing of forgiveness (1:7b)
- C. We are forgiven because God chose to lavish the riches of His grace on us (1:7c-8a).

II. *Christ's Rule*: We know <u>God's plan to rule forever through Christ</u> (Ephesians 1:8b-10).

- A. In His wisdom God revealed His plan for all of history to us in the church (1:8b-10a).
- B. God's plan is to some day rule all things through Christ (1:10b).

III. *God's Glory*: The real reason we are saved is so that <u>God will be</u> <u>glorified for His grace through Christ</u> (Ephesians 1:11-12; 1:6a).

- A. We were chosen to be "in Christ" according to God's eternal plan (1:11).
- B. God chose to save us through faith in Christ so that we would live fully for His glory (1:12).

<u>Main Point</u>: God saved us through Christ not simply for our benefit, but ultimately so that He will forever be glorified.
