I. PRETTY FEET WITH GOOD NEWS (ROMANS 10:13-15)

- A. Salvation is there for all who call on the name of the Lord.
- B. To call they need to believe.
- C. To believe they need to hear.
- D. To hear they need to be told.
- E. For them to be told, someone must go tell them.
- F. How beautiful are the feet of those who bring this good news!
 - Who brought you the good news?
 - How beautiful are their feet to you?

II. GOD'S PLAN FOR SPREADING GOOD NEWS (ACTS 1:1-11)

- A. Depend upon the Holy Spirit (4-5).
 - We are tempted to try do things in our own strength.
 - We do not have the ability to change hearts.
 - God takes our wah-wah-wah's... Trust Him!
- B. Witness/testify of what Jesus has done for you (8b).
 - A witness is one who just tells what they saw or experienced.
 - A witness does not need to know the whole story but just willing to tell what they do know or saw.
 - You don't have to convince people, just tell people.
 - Your testimony doesn't have to be difficult.
- C. Start close and work out? (8c)
 - Jerusalem (start with those closest)
 - Judea and Samaria (begin to move outward)
 - Ends of the earth (both figurative and literal)
- D. Don't forget the Why! (11)
 - Jesus is coming back.
 - Someone shared the good news with us.
 - They cannot know, unless someone tells them.
