A Life God can Bless

Joshua 23

- I. <u>Joshua's Review</u>: God has blessed you and wants to continue to bless you (23:1-5).
 - A. <u>Kept Promises</u>: Remember how God fought for you (1-3).
 - B. Future Promises: Depend on God to keep fighting for you (4, 5).
- II. <u>Joshua's Exhortation</u>: Live the kind of life God that God can bless (23:6-11)
 - A. Be Strong (6a).
 - B. Obey God's Word persistently (6b).
 - C. Be <u>Separate</u> (7-11).
 - 1. Avoid alliances with unbelievers who will lead you into idolatry (7).

Who's Influencing Who?

When I am with unbelieving friends...

- Heart Test: Am I burdened for them or am I envious of them?
- Identity Test: Do I hide or minimize my identity as a believer?
- <u>Choice Test</u>: Do I do or say things I wouldn't do or say otherwise?
 - The Idolatry Issue today: Materialism and any other desire that has the power to repeatedly distract or tempt us is our idol.
 - 2. The solution to wrong alliances and idolatry is to cling to God and love Him only (8-11).
- III. <u>Joshua's Warnings</u>: Remember what happens when we disobey (23:12-16).
 - A. God wouldn't give Israel victory over the nations if they allied themselves with them (12-13).
 - B. God has kept and will keep His promises, but He will also keep His warnings (14-16).
