How to Pray for Each Other Ephesians 1:15-23

I. Thank God for their spiritual progress (Ephesians 1:15-16). A. Thank God they are growing in their faith.

B. Thank God they are learning to love all believers.

II. Ask God to help them know Him better (Ephesians 1:17-18a).

- A. Pray for increasing insight about God (17).
- B. Growing knowledge of God is possible since our spiritual eyes were opened at salvation (18a).

III. Ask God to help them better understand their spiritual blessings (Ephesians 1:18b-19a).

- A. The <u>Hope</u> of our calling The confidence that we will live forever in heaven (18b)
 - Pray they will live truly thankful for salvation.
- B. The Riches of our <u>Inheritance</u> Great privileges in heaven (18c)
 Pray they will value eternal things over earthly things.
- C. God's <u>Power</u> in our lives The strength of God working in our lives daily (19-23)
 1. The power that raised Christ is available to us (19-20).
 - God exerted his power to raise Christ to glorify Christ above all things forever in His church (21-23)
 - Pray that Christ will be glorified by God's miraculous power working in their life.
