## SERMON OUTLINE

## The Truly Wise

James 3:13-18

- I. Theme: The truly wise show it by living with a humble attitude (James 3:13).
  - A. True wisdom shows in our deeds, not our position.
  - B. Deeds are sincere only if they arise from humility.
- II. <u>Satan's "wisdom"</u> Satan stirs up arrogance that destroy relationships (James 3:14-16).
  - A. *Bitter envy/Selfish ambition/Boast/Deny truth* When we have these attitudes, we think we are right, but are actually damaging God's truth (14).
    - Bitter envy "Righteous" zeal that warps into bitterness
    - Selfish ambition Striving to "be somebody" or to convince others to agree or follow us
  - B. False "Wisdom" Such attitudes are actually from our sinful nature and Satan (15).
  - C. Disorder and Evil Satan uses these traits to multiply sin and chaos (16).
- III. <u>God's true wisdom</u> God produces humility that draws people together (James 3:17-18).
  - A. Wisdom from heaven God seeks to produce good relationships based in humility (17).
    - Purity Motivated by pleasing God, not myself
    - Peace-loving Eager to get along with all
    - Considerate Gentle, considers feelings of others
    - Submissive Teachable, flexible, not stubborn
    - *Mercy/fruit* Accepts/forgives those who fail, compassion
    - Impartial Not judging, not prejudiced
    - Sincerity Not a hypocrite, sincere love not pretending
  - B. Peacemaking and Righteousness God uses these traits to multiply righteousness (18).
