It's all God's Grace

Ephesians 2:8-10

I. <u>Faith</u>: How we say <u>Yes</u> to God's grace gift of salvation (Ephesians 2:8-9).

- A. <u>By Grace:</u> God treats sinners with undeserved favor (Romans 6:23).
- B. <u>Saved:</u> God withholds His just wrath from those who believe (Romans 5:9; John 3:36).
- C. <u>Through Faith</u> A person is *saved* by choosing to trust in Christ's death on the cross (John 3:16).
- D. <u>A gift</u>: Salvation is dependent on God alone (8b).
 - 1. God paid for the gift; we receive it like a child (Mark 10:15).
- E. <u>Not works</u>: No effort of ours helps to merit salvation (9a).
- F. <u>That no one boasts</u>: God made salvation entirely dependent on Him so the credit goes only to Him (9b).

II. <u>Good Works</u>: How we say <u>*Thank You*</u> to God for His grace gift of salvation (Ephesians 2:10).

- A. <u>We are His workmanship Created in Christ Jesus</u>: Salvation is entirely God's doing (10a).
- B. <u>For (the purpose of) good works</u>: Good works are the *result* of salvation not the *cause* (10b)!
 - 1. We are *thanking God* for salvation when we do good works!
- C. God prepared/planned our good works before we were saved (10c).
 - 1. Our good works can't earn God's favor, because He planned them before we were saved!
 - 2. We are to "walk in" good works = Good works can only be done by God working through us (Philippians 2:13).

Evaluating our good works as believers

- 1. Are we doing the good works God planned for us?
- 2. Are we distracted from good works by sin? Are we just too busy?
- 3. Are we really doing the works God designed for us, or are we doing the ones we want to do for our selfish reasons?
