God-focused at my Work

Selected Proverbs

I. Understand God's Plan for work.

- A. God worked and then "rested" (Genesis 2:1-3).
- B. Adam worked before there was sin (Genesis 2:5, 15).
- C. Work became painful after sin, but it still honors Him (Genesis 3:17-19; Colossians 3:22-24).

II. Pursue God-focused **Satisfaction** at work.

- A. Work requires costly effort.
 - 1. Work is hard and messy (Proverbs 12:11; 14:4; 14:23).
 - 2. Work is an endless necessity (16:26).
- B. Work produces satisfying rewards.
 - 1. Enjoy provision and wealth (6:6-11; 10:4; 12:11; 28:19)
 - 2. Enjoy advancement (12:24).
 - 3. Enjoy completing and achieving (12:27; 13:4)

III. Pursue God-focused Success at work.

- A. Work hard consistently (13:11; 31:13, 15, 17, 18, 27).
- B. Plan well to improve effectiveness (21:5).
- C. Develop your skills Excellence and efficiency (22:29).
- D. Prioritize your tasks at work (24:27).
- E. Avoid meddling and gossip at work (26:17-22, 30:10).
- F. Address the temptations of laziness.
 - 1. Laziness brings poverty (6:11; 10:4; 19:15, 24; 20:13), shame (10:5), servitude (12:24) trouble (15:19), loss to employer (18:9)
 - 2. Lazy people sleep a lot (20:13; 24:33-34) and make a lot of excuses (22:13).
- G. Balance your work and rest (23:4).

IV. Stay focused on God's plan for work – 3 Tests

- A. Do I consider pleasing God to be my real job at work (Colossians 3:22-24)?
- B. Do I believe God deserves the credit for my success at work (Deuteronomy 8:17-18)?
- C. Is my faithful work a good witness for Christ (Titus 2:9-12; 1 Thessalonians 4: 11-12)?
