Leading Our Kids To True Greatness

- I. <u>Embrace Serving</u> God's definition of true greatness is servanthood (Matthew 20:20-28).
 - A. True greatness is the exact opposite of human success and rank (Matthew 20:20-25).
 - What James and John's Mother was really saving
 - 1. My child's rank in this world is the most important issue for them.
 - 2. My own image is wrapped up in my child's success.
 - 3. I'm a controller. I will push to make things happen for my child no matter how old they are.
 - B. True greatness is actually found in serving people like Christ did instead of serving self like the rest of the world does (Matthew 20:26-28).
- II. <u>Model Serving</u> We must do what God calls truly great so that our children know how to serve.
 - A. True greatness is found in making the needs and interests of others more important than our own like Christ did (Philippians 2:3-4, 5-11).
 - B. True greatness is found in doing for others what others don't want to do (John 13:4-5, 12-17).
 - C. True greatness is found in serving those less fortunate who cannot repay us (Matthew 25:37-40; Luke 14:13-14).
