Together as Christ's Church Ephesians 2:18-22

- I. <u>Context</u>: All believers have equal access to God (Ephesians 2:18). A. We all have access to God through Christ (2:18a).
 - B. We all have access to God by the Spirit (2:18b).
 - II. <u>The Country</u>: We are fellow-citizens of the same country spiritually (Ephesians 2:19a).
 - We share citizenship in heaven (Philippians 3:20)
 - As "citizens" we have a place where we really **belong**.
 - III. <u>The Family</u>: We are members of the same family spiritually (Ephesians 2:19b).
 - We have same heavenly Father (2:18; 3:14; John 1:12).
 - As "family" we have people who truly *accept* us.
 - IV. <u>The Temple</u>: We are a building in which God dwells by the Spirit (Ephesians 2:20-22).

A. <u>Leadership</u>: The Foundation of the Church is the apostles and prophets with Christ the Cornerstone (20).

- <u>Christ</u> established the church by the cross and has continuous total authority (1:22; 1 Corinthians 3:11).
- <u>The Apostles and Prophets</u> (12 + Paul, Barnabas etc.) had Christ's unique authority to start the church.
 - 1. <u>Directing</u> the early church (Acts 6:1; 15:1-2)
 - 2. <u>Performing miracles</u> to substantiate the gospel message before the New Testament (2 Corinthians 12:12; Mark 16:20; Acts 14:3; Hebrews 2:3-4)
 - 3. <u>Directly speaking God's word</u> before the New Testament and then writing it down (Acts 8:25, etc.; 1 Corinthians 7:10; 1 Thessalonians 4:15)
- B. <u>Unity</u>: God chooses to dwell today in us as believers who are joined together by His Spirit (21-22).
 - Do we relate to each other as if we are <u>joined</u> to "one another?"
 - Do we realize our relationships with other believers are how God the Holy Spirit <u>dwells in us</u> corporately?
