The Beauty of the Church Ephesians 3:1-13

<u>Context</u>: Paul was about to pray but digressed to further explain God's plan for the church age (Ephesians 3:1, 14).

- I. <u>Paul's Beautiful Privilege:</u> Paul was chosen to unveil God's plan to unite Jews and Gentiles in the Church (Ephesians 3:2-6).
 - A. <u>Paul's Assignment</u>: The "mystery" of the church was uniquely revealed by God to Paul (3:2-3).
 - B. <u>The Church age</u>: The church was not known in the Old Testament and no one knew it was coming (3:4-5).
 - C. <u>The Mystery revealed</u>: The mystery of the church was that Jews and Gentiles are joined equally in Christ (3:6).
- II. <u>God's Beautiful Intent</u>: God established the church to display His grace (Ephesians 3:7-13).
 - A. <u>Impact on Paul</u>: Paul felt wonderfully and graciously privileged to reveal the church (3:7-9).
 - B. <u>Impact on Angels</u>: The angels worship God for his wise plan to unite a great variety of people in the church (3:10-11).
 - C. <u>Impact on Believers</u>: We should approach God confidently in prayer and not be discouraged as we serve the cause of Christ (3:12-13).
