

Impressed with Jesus

Mark 1:21-34

- I. At the Synagogue in Capernaum: People were **amazed** at Jesus and the news of Him spread (Mark 1:22-28).
 - A. Teaching – The people were amazed as Jesus revealed His authority by His teaching (1:21-22).
 - Jesus' teaching revealed the power of God's Word (Hebrews 4:12).
 - B. Demons – The people were amazed as Jesus revealed His authority by casting out an evil spirit and everyone began to hear about it (1:23-28).
 - Application: Is there something unique about our life that shows people the amazing power of Jesus? Does something about us cause them to think, wonder and consider Jesus?

- II. At Peter's home in Capernaum: People were **changed** by Jesus and more people came for help (Mark 1:29-34).
 - A. Jesus healed Peter's mother-in-law (1:29-31).
 - B. Jesus healed and delivered others who had diseases and demons (1:32-34).
 - Application: Are we impressed with Jesus? Is it amazement or is it worship? Are we exalting Him or just wanting help from Him? Is Jesus our safety net, or is He our Lord?
