Why Godliness must be our Parenting Goal

I. <u>Godliness is God's goal</u> for our parenting.

- A. God's design for marriage is spiritual unity and faithfulness (Malachi 2:10-14, 16).
 - Spiritual unity between husband and wife (10-12)
 - Faithful harmony as a couple (13-14, 16)
- B. God's purpose for our parenting is godly children (Malachi 2:15).
- II. <u>God blesses our children</u> when we parent with the goal of godliness. – (Proverbs 20:7) "The righteous man leads a blameless life; blessed are his children after him."
 - A. Children whose parents are committed to worship and God's word often have a <u>positive impact</u> in the world (Psalms 112:1-2).
 - B. Children who are parented to obey God often <u>live longer</u> because they avoid natural consequences of sin (Ephesians 6:1-3; Exodus 20:12; Proverbs 19:18).

III. <u>We can trust God with our children</u> when we parent with the goal of godliness.

- A. We can trust God to discipline and guide our children when they struggle with sin (Hebrews 12:5,6,11).
- B. We can trust God to use trials to bring about things that truly best for our child (Romans 8:28).
