Learning to put on our new clothes Ephesians 4:17-24

I. The way we were – Stop living like unbelievers (Ephesians 4:17-19).

- A. We must stop living like unbelievers because it is totally inconsistent with who we are (4:17a).
- B. Empty, Dark Minds: Unbelievers don't understand godly living (17b, 18a).
- C. <u>Spiritually Dead</u>: Unbelievers do not have a spiritual capacity because they don't have spiritual life (18b).
- D. Obstinate Will: Ungodly living comes from deliberately hardened wills (4:18c).
- E. <u>Reckless Living</u>: Unbelievers often indulge in immorality because they live to please themselves (4:19).
- II. The way we can be I can live differently as I "put on" my new nature which God empowers (4:20-24).
 - A. We know the truth of how we can live because of Christ (4:20-21).
 - B. <u>Put off</u> We can choose to put off our corrupt sin nature (4:22).
 - C. <u>Think New</u> We can choose to be made new in our minds (4:23).
 - D. <u>Put on</u> We can choose to put on our new nature and make consistent godly choices (4:24).
